### **Who are you?**

- I am Dr. Donna Campbell and I'm running for Congress to limit federal government to the bounds of the U.S. Constitution as written—not as interpreted. This will shrink the national debt and restore governing power to the states.
- Increasingly upset about the eroding power of the states to govern, and the increasing power that Washington is amassing over our daily lives, I looked around the room for someone to stand up and reverse the rising tide of socialism .... and stopped after glancing in the mirror.
- Having won my March primary with nearly 70 percent of the vote, my team and I are working to unseat ultra-liberal Lloyd Doggett so Central Texans can finally have the conservative representation they deserve!
- In the U.S. House of Representatives, I'll work to enact a form of the fair tax in place of the unfair federal tax on income, and I'll fight to lift burdensome regulations to create jobs for Texas and the nation.
- I'm strong on immigration law enforcement and national defense (which are interlinked), and I'll hold spending in check so our children and grandchildren aren't saddled with crushing debt.
- An E.R. doctor, wife and adoptive mother concerned about the nation's future for our children and those yet to be born, I will fight to make adoption easier to help more pregnant women commit to giving birth.
- I feel the Second Amendment is very clear: We Texans and all law-abiding American citizens have the right to keep and bear arms.

### **What makes you qualified for the job?**

- In drafting our Constitution, the Founders put special emphasis on the U.S. House of Representatives being the legislative chamber most closely and directly in tune with the nation's citizens, and can fall to a complete 435-member makeover every two years. It is a legislative body made up of citizens, representing citizens.
- As a citizen who currently feels poorly represented in the U.S. House, and knowing an overwhelming majority of citizens in the 25<sup>th</sup> District feeling the same, I am working to restore the representation we deserve in the House and feel I have the life experiences and professional qualifications needed to do the job and do it well.
  - And with healthcare being the dominant topic of national debate, I can bring my firsthand experience as a medical professional to the table.

### **What have you done as a conservative?**

- First off, I've been a lifelong conscientious and diligent voter for fiscally and socially conservative candidates and conservative-aligned ballot issues.
- Secondly, I have lived the tenets of fiscal and social conservatism in my personal, professional and spiritual lives: Strong national defense, moral integrity, fiscal responsibility, and a strict adherence to the Constitution.
- Thirdly, rather than just be content to commiserate with folks about the decline this nation has embarked on over the past year, I've put my name on the line as one who wants to step up and do something about restoring this nation of ours to the greatness it once held and can again hold.

In three broad brushstrokes, I am:

- Strong on national defense (including border policing and immigration law enforcement) and will help keep Americans safe.
- A strong constitutionalist who will help keep government out of our homes, businesses wallets and lives.
- A fiscal hawk who will cut spending, which will lower taxes, which will foster job retention and creation.

### **Who are you running against?**

- I prefer to frame my race as *running for* U.S. Congress, rather than *running against* a person, but this is hardly and uncontested bid.
  - My first milestone in my campaign was the March 2 primary, in which I faced fellow Republican George Morovich. In that contest I earned 70 percent of the vote.
  - I now face incumbent Congressman Lloyd Doggett in the general election. (An Independent and a Libertarian are also in the general election.)

### **How are you poised to remove the incumbent?**

I can beat Lloyd Doggett in the general election and break up the good ol' boy club in D.C. to make things better here in the heart of Texas.

- I am endorsed by the Texas Alliance for Life, and an endorsement has been pledged by Team America, and other organizations.
- I am working to make inroads with the black and Hispanic communities in CD 25 by partnering with black and Hispanic candidates.
- I am actively working to identify and engage moderates and independents in CD 25.
- I am working to connect with resources outside CD 25 and outside Texas to broaden support for me and my campaign.
- The nation as a whole is railing against incumbencies, while at the same time, the political pendulum is swinging from left to right.
- I live, breathe and deliver healthcare, the nation's still dominant topic of debate; my opponent is a trial attorney. The attorney had a run at healthcare reform; let's see what a doctor can do about making healthcare truly accessible and sustainable.

### **What would you first set out to do on taking office?**

I have the personality and ability to bring people together and make tomorrow a better day. Just as I've been building a coalition of supporters in CD 25, I would build a coalition of like-minded lawmakers in Washington to ensure the Constitution and its unalienable rights of Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness are upheld.

I'd also take a page from many of those taking office as president, and by this I mean I will set—and follow—a clear course of action for my first 100 days of office.

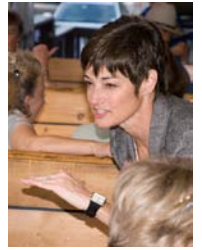
- I will meet with our complete Texas congressional delegation—this means folks from both sides of the aisle.

- I will work to forge stronger communication ties between Washington and Texas, most especially here in the 25<sup>th</sup> District.
